Your Room is Ready: Tourism and Urban Revival *Job Market Paper*

Tourism is an essential sector of the global economy, contributing significantly to GDP and employment. Despite its importance, our understanding of its impact on urban economic activity remains limited. This paper aims to fill this gap by examining the impact of tourism on urban transformation using a dataset of hotel openings in Madrid over the period 2001-2010. I show that hotel openings have a positive impact on the number of establishments and employment by using the number of protected buildings as an instrumental variable to account for the non-random distribution of hotel openings. Interestingly, the impacts vary between different economic sectors and areas within the city, with tourism-oriented businesses benefiting significantly while production-oriented activities experience negative impacts. In addition, the spatial impacts of tourism extend beyond the immediate vicinity, suggesting indirect economic spillover effects on job creation in more distant areas. Finally, economic effects extend to the real estate market, increasing rental prices and residential investment.

The Effect of Short-Term Rentals on Local Consumption Amenities: Evidence from Madrid Hidalgo, A., Riccaboni, A. and Velázquez, F. *Link* *Conditionally accepted at the Journal of Regional Science*

This paper investigates the impact of the arrival of Airbnb on local consumption amenities in Madrid. We exploit the exogenous variation created by the timing and the unequal distribution of Airbnb listings across the urban geography to identify its effects on food and beverage establishments. Using an instrumental variable strategy, we find positive local effects on both the number of restaurants and their employees: an increase in ten Airbnb rooms in a given census tract translates into almost one more restaurant, and the same increase in a given neighborhood generates eight new tourist-related employees. The results are robust to specification and sample composition. This paper contributes to the literature on the economic impacts of the platform economy in urban areas by providing evidence of market expansion externalities from short-term rentals.
